

Dear Friends,

I'd like to share with you the following statement which was released by Bishop Michael F. Burbidge of Arlington, VA, Chairman of the *U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops' (USCCB) Committee on Pro-Life Activities*:

".....we celebrate the thousands of pregnancy care centers providing life-saving help to the most vulnerable group in our society: pregnant women in need......Our country's network of pregnancy care centers and maternity homes work to ensure that no woman is left alone in her own hour of need. These centers provide a spectrum of resources including baby clothes and diapers, childcare and career services, referrals to homes where pregnant and parenting moms can live for free, and many other forms of housing, food, and financial assistance. Many pregnancy care centers also provide some medical services, including ultrasounds, prenatal and postnatal care, and referrals to hospitals for free or low-cost childbirth. Their loving service and profound accompaniment continues far beyond the birth of the child, with mothers reporting that their pregnancy care center "never let them go." We commend pregnancy help centers for their faithful love of Christ in serving vulnerable mothers."

In the United States there are approximately 2,750 crisis pregnancy centers offering life-affirming support to pregnant women and families. Here, at *Life Choices Resource Center*, we are graced by **God** to help provide much-needed and life-affirming aid to those most in need -- pregnant and parenting women and families! Our staff, volunteers, and donors help them to see "the dawn of a new day" in welcoming the birth of a new baby. We strive to give hope, and "never let them go" when their world fails.

As we "Walk with Moms in Need" we couldn't do what we do without **YOUR love and support**! And so, during this Christmas season, we are **grateful** to you as you partner with us in your prayers and support of *Life Choices RC*. Each mother matters. Each family models the Holy Family.


